

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

The entire EngFrosh Planning team has done an amazing job transitioning the week to an online format. The online activities have been very engaging, and it has encouraged many awesome people to get involved in the community.

However, speaking from a purely nostalgic point of view, GOD I miss the in-person week. The week just had such an amazing energy to it which engulfed everyone. Everywhere you looked people were cheering, dancing, talking, and getting to know one another.

The first two days (for everyone but the frosh) were Move-Ins. This was the time when you REALLY bonded with the Facils and Heads. It felt like you were down in the mines, working day in and day out, but people were still so happy and energetic (even after climbing to the top of Glengarry). Nothing brings more joy to upper years than seeing a first year's face (and their parents) when you scream "POP THAT TRUNK" or "TURN THAT KEY". 




CENG: "That makes sense. Can I upload a picture like this? (Insert Meme Here)"

Fashion



CENG: "Wow that's cool. I never thought I would say this but I have an urge to sell my leg."


-_- Maybe don't sell your leg quite yet. There are more ways to make money.


Conclusion

After 3 and a half years of suffering aided by nothing but these tools and sheer force of will, I bring you Aaron's Definitive and Objectively Correct Guide To Stationary: The List of MF Thangs I Keep On Me.

Pencil – Pentel Graphgear 1000 - \$15



I've gone through 3 of these now. That's a single pencil every 18 months, and that's just from losing them. The build quality is great, it feels good in the hands and allows great control during drafting, sketching, notetaking, or math. It comes in all common led sizes. This pencil looks good, feels good, commands the respect of your peers, and will be there with you through to the end of every exam.

Lead – Ain Stein HB - \$3



The lead is just as important as the pencil, and the Ain Stein by Pentel writes like butter. It's a little more money, but a pack of 40 leads will last you a while.

Eraser – Tombow Mono Black -\$2



It's an eraser that actually works. Enough said.

Pen – Pilot G2 - \$2



They feel good, leave clean lines, dry quick for gel pens, and aren't too expensive (so you don't have to worry about dropping one behind the chairs in the back of Bell Theatre).

Coloured Pens – Staedtler Triplus Fineliner - \$16



Fine-tip, sharp lines, and vibrant colours. I use these during notetaking to craft the most intense diagrams. MAAE2700 was illegible without at least 6 colours, ELEC3909 needed all 10.

Notebook – Leuchtturm1917 A5 Dotted Hardcover - \$28



I unironically keep this mf thang on me. A5 is the perfect size to carry around while being big enough to sketch and take notes. Dotted paper is the ideal layout (though they also sell ruled and blank), the build quality is excellent, it comes in thousands of colours[Citation needed] and it's packed with features like ribbons and pockets and labels to remind you that this is a premium product. They're a little pricey, but the \$28 is worth it compared to the valuable information you'll write within.

Dry-Erase Whiteboard – Expo Dry-Erase Markers - \$12



When I researched products for my whiteboard, I was really hoping there was some great Japanese or German brand of dry-erase markers. Unfortunately, Expo is as good as it gets. Note: To avoid the markers drying out, make sure you store them cap-down!

Wet-Erase Whiteboard – Staedtler Lumocolor Markers - \$8



These are pretty much your only option for wet-erase markers. The quality is great, though!

Non-Programmable Calculator – Sharp 516 - \$30
