ELECTION TIMELINE

- Nomination Period: Monday, February 28th, 2022 @ 8:30 to Friday, March 4th at 17:30.
- All-Candidates Meeting: Friday, March 4th @ 18:00 Online.
- Town Hall: Wednesday, March 9th @ 18:00 Online
- Campaigning Period: Monday, March 7th @ 8:30 to Friday, March 11th @ 23:59.
- Voting Period: Monday, March 14th @ 0:00 to Friday March 18th @ 23:59.

LOCATIONS

- All election materials, including nomination forms and regulations, will be available on the CSES website and social media communications.
- Completed nomination forms must also be submitted to the CEO's email before 17:30 on Friday, March 4th, 2022.
- All voting will take place online via a link provided to all students through the CU email system.

RESTRICTIONS

- Students wishing to run for a Program Representative position may only run for a seat that represents their own stream of engineering. Similarly, students may not nominate nor vote for Program Representative candidates that will not represent them;
- The number of seats for a particular position represents the maximum number of candidates a student may nominate and/or vote for, for that position;
- Students may not nominate themselves for any position;
- In order to be on CSES Council, all persons must be 18 years of age or older by March 18th, 2022.
 - In the event a candidate is running while under the age of 18 and is elected to the position, they will fully assume the position upon their turning 18 provided they do not turn 18 after the period in which their position's term expires.
- In order to run for CSES Council, you must still be opting in to CSES membership fees.
