1. First-Year Representatives (2)

Number of candidates = 7

The two candidates with the most votes are **Hope Udoh** and **Marcie Orrell**.

2. Sustainable and Renewable Energy Engineering (SREEB) Representative

Number of invitees = 101

Number of valid responses = 30

Invitee response rate = 29.7%

Number of candidates = 1 (**Sebastian Vives**)

| Response | Number of Votes |
|-------------------------------|-----------------|
| Support this candidate | 25 |
| Do not support this candidate | 0 |
| Abstain | 5 |

Sebastian Vives is confirmed as the CSES SREE B representative with an 83.33% confidence vote (25/30).
