Can You Hear the Music is definitely the central piece of the movie. It starts off with ascending strings that are so



The Daemon Tarot Deck works differently from the standard deck. These cards do not have a major or minor Arcana. Instead, there is a roster of 69 demon cards that can be pulled through a reading.

With this deck, certain cards can pop-up as "tricksters". These cards show up to attempt to misguide you. If the description of a card's characteristics does not seem to apply to you, that card is your trickster card. You have been fooled, hoodwinked even.

The Process (How I Pull Cards)

The process behind how cards are pulled is rather simple. The deck is taken and shuffled until certain cards fall out. If a spread calls for one card and 2 or 3 happen to drop, those cards are used for the reading, as they all work to describe the prompt:).




